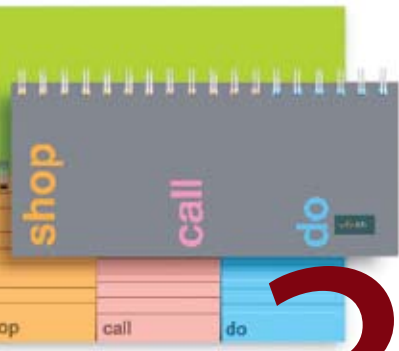




Thank Goodness!
